R40 Linking Emmer Green and the feeder routes through Caversham Heights to local facilities with some steep hills along the way. The route passes Highdown School and Sports Centre, Caversham Library and Caversham Centre then extends to Rivermead Leisure Complex and Reading Station via the Thames Path through the popular leisure and play park at Christchurch Meadows. The route links to National Cycle Route 5 at each end offering longer distance leisure riding.

R41 Connecting Emmer Green to Reading Station via route R4 this route utilises mainly residential roads and shared use paths. Old Peppard Road provides links to BBC Caversham Park and The Hill Primary School before using a short shared use path between The Horse Close and Chiltern Road, linking to route R4 at Star Rd. R4 From Caversham Park Village through residential areas to Reading Station. The route makes use of a number of quiet residential roads and shared use paths, including Milestone Way. The route continues along Henley Road, passing close to Henley Road Cemetery and via the toucan crossings and the contraflow cycle lane on Star Road, to the riverside at Hills Meadow and on to Reading Station via Reading Bridge.
