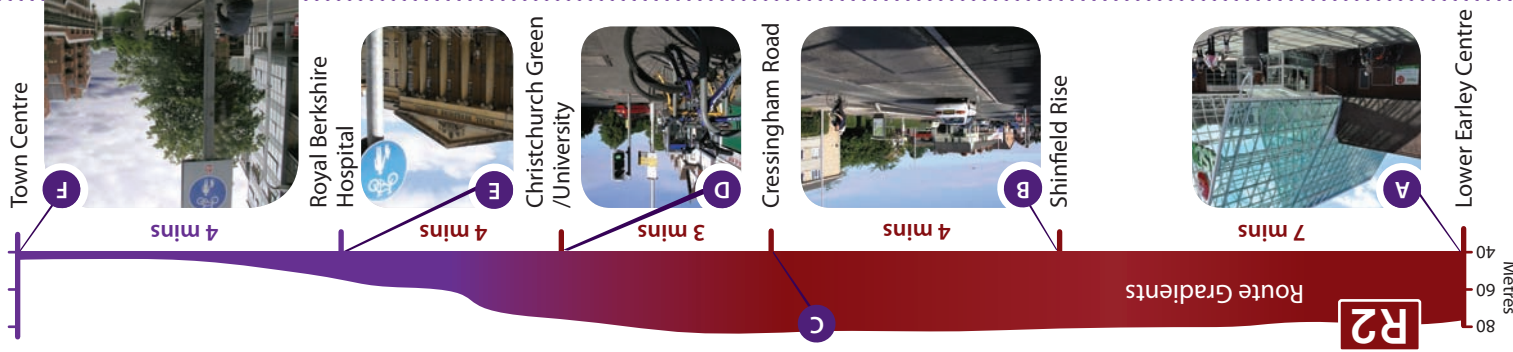


**R20**  
A329 cycle way providing an off-road route to Earley Station and the University of Reading. R20 uses quieter roads through Earley and Redlands, past the Kennet side cycleway into central Reading from Watlington Street.

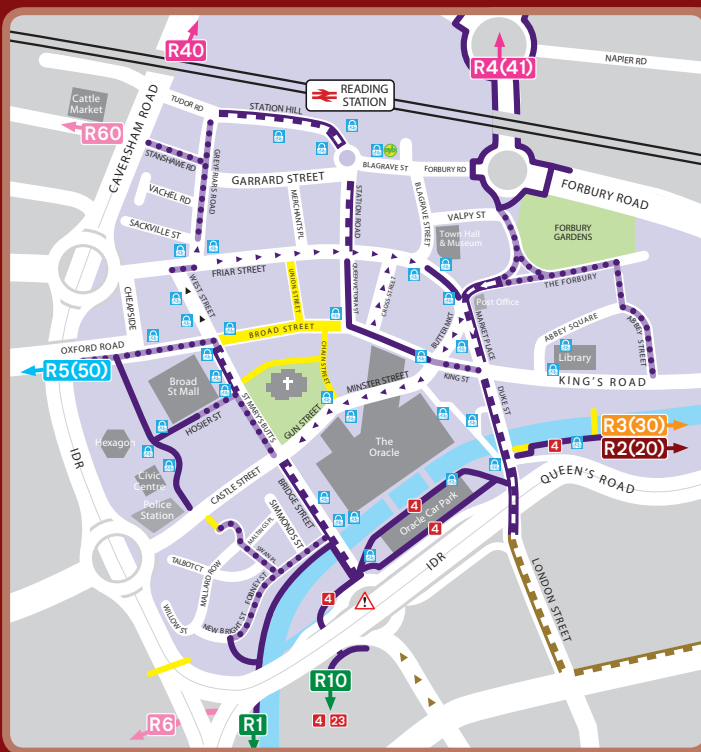

**R2**  
From the Lower Earley District Centre R2 utilises off-road cycleways to connect to Shinfield Rise. Quiet roads along the East Reading Ridge bring the route to Christchurch Green and Reading University's main entrance from where R2 passes the Royal Berkshire Hospital, joining R20 at Watlington Street to follow the Kennet side cycleway into central Reading.
