The Borough of Reading (Civil Enforcement Area)
(Waiting Restrictions Review 2016 A) Order 2016
Battle Ward

Reading Borough Council under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to 3, 4(2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and under the provisions of Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 intends to make an Order the effects of which are:

To introduce, remove or amend existing waiting restrictions and parking places either in the interests of safety or in response to demand. This has necessitated changing or revising existing Traffic Orders.

Drawing No. WRR/2016A/BA1

Portman Way

North side: Introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' from its junction with Portman Road to a point 69m east of that junction.

South side: Introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' from its junction with Portman Road to a point 22m east of that junction.

South side: Introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' around its junction with Battle Square (western section).

South side: Introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' at its junction with Battle Square (eastern section).

Battle Square (eastern section)

West side: Introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' from a point 42m south of its junction with Portman Way to 109m south of that point.

West side: Introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' at its junction with Curzon Street.

East side: Introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' from a point 55m south of its junction with Portman Way to its junction with Curzon Street.

Curzon Street

South side: Introduce a length of 'No Waiting at Any Time' from its junction with Battle Square (eastern section) to its junction with Battle Square (western section).

Battle Place

Introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' from its junction with Curzon Street to a point 13m south of that junction.

Drawing No. WRR/2016A/BA2

Loverock Road

North side: Extend existing 'No Waiting at Any Time' to a point 67m east of its junction with Littlejohns Lane.
