(Waiting Restrictions Review 2016 A) Order 2016
Kentwood Ward

Reading Borough Council under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to 3, 4(2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and under the provisions of Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 intends to make an Order the effects of which are:

To introduce, remove or amend existing waiting restrictions and parking places either in the interests of safety or in response to demand. This has necessitated changing or revising existing Traffic Orders.

Drawing No. WRR16A/KE1

Broomfield Road

Southeast side: Introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' from a point 35m northeast of its junction with Glenrosa Road to a point 75m northeast of that junction.

Drawing No. NM/WRR16A/KE2

Overdown Road

South side: Extend existing 'No Waiting Mon-Fri 11am-12pm' from a point 15m west of its junction with Larkwood Close to a point 10m east of its junction with Brooksby Road.

North side: Introduce 'No Waiting Mon-Fri 12pm-1pm' from a point 10m west of its junction with Elsley Road to a point 8m west of its junction with Brooksby Road.

South side: Introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' around its junction with Brooksby Road.

Romany Close

North side: Introduce 10m of 'No Waiting at Any Time' on the bend.

Drawing No. WRR/2016A/KE4

Pottery Road

West side: Introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' from its junction with Wealden Way to a point 22m south of that junction.

Drawing No. WRR/2016A/KE4

Wealden Way

South side: Extend existing 'No Waiting at Any Time' opposite Dartington Close to its junction with Pottery Road.
