Reading Borough Council under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to 3, 4(2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and under the provisions of Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 intends to make an Order the effects of which are:

To introduce, remove or amend existing waiting restrictions and parking places either in the interests of safety or in response to demand. This has necessitated changing or revising existing Traffic Orders.

- West side: Introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' from its junction with Carmelite Drive to a point 8m south of that junction.
- East side: Introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' around its junction with Josephine Court.
