(Waiting Restrictions Review 2016 A) Order 2016
Tilehurst Ward

Reading Borough Council under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to 3, 4(2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and under the provisions of Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 intends to make an Order the effects of which are:

To introduce, remove or amend existing waiting restrictions and parking places either in the interests of safety or in response to demand. This has necessitated changing or revising existing Traffic Orders.

Drawing No. WRR/2016A/TO1

Church End Lane

West side: Introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' from the boundary of no. 36a to the boundary of no. 24.

Drawing No. WRR16A/TO2

Mayfair

Extend existing 'No Waiting at Any Time' on both sides from its junction with Park Lane to a point 76m southeast of that junction.

Drawing No. WRR16A/TO3_A

St Michaels Road

Southwest side: Extend existing 'No Waiting at Any Time' from its junction with Woodland Drive to a point 50m southeast of that junction.

Southeast side: Change existing waiting restriction to 'No Waiting at Any Time' from its junction with School Road to a point 162m southeast of that junction.

Northeast side: Change existing waiting restriction and section of existing limited waiting bay to 'No Waiting at Any Time' from its junction with School Road to a point 37m southeast of that junction.

Westwood Road

Introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' around its junction with Crescent Road
