THE BOROUGH OF READING (E. P. COLLIER SCHOOL) (20 MPH ZONE) ORDER 2016

The Reading Borough Council propose making an order under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to impose a 20mph speed limit along the entire lengths of the following roads:-

**Schedule
20mph Zone**

Randolf Road - For its entire length
Newport Road - For its entire length
Addison Road - For its entire length
Cardiff Road - From its junction with Swansea Road to a point 320m west of its junction
Ross Road - For its entire length
York Road - For its entire length
Swansea Road - For its entire length
Northfield Road - For its entire length
Barry Place - For its entire length
Denbeigh Road - For its entire length
Meadow Road - From its junction with Addison Road to a point 25m west

To facilitate the proposed restrictions the following restrictions will be revoked if the order is made:

The Borough of Reading (Safer Routes to School) Speed Limit Order 2003
Schedule 1 York Road
Schedule 1 Ross Road
