THE BOROUGH OF READING (WEST READING STUDY) ORDER 2017

Reading Borough Council under Sections 1, 2, 4, and 84 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act of 1984”) and after consultation in accordance with the police under Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 as amended intends to make an Order the effects of which are:

To introduce a bus lane, 20 mph speed limit/zone for the entire length of the roads detailed in Schedules 2 and 3, one-way traffic restriction and no waiting at any time restrictions as detailed in the Schedules below.
